

Morris D Shields-Diary entries #2-March 28, 1935 to April 21, 1935

AGES: Leland-26, Clyde-24, Ned-21, Morris-18, Elden-17, Barbara 14, Grant-10, Wallace-6, Grant-4

March 28 -Weather chilly, some snow, good radio shows tonight and Hawian music

March 29-Went to "Mutual Ward Honour", program and dance, uncle George Terry visiting

March 30-Went to Saturday session of Stake "Honour" Program, Lethbridge, supper at Pratts, attended evening program, opera by a Lethbridge Ward and a play by a Taber Ward. Dance until midnight, car trouble going home

March 31-**Diamond City Ward Conference**, attended all 3 sessions, work on Mutual record book

April 2-preparing for talk at Church on Sunday, some arguments over keeping quiet, while radio on

April 5-Worked on Scout Roll book, attended Scout meeting, boys and girls from the Diamond Ward here tonight for party (had a good time)

April 6-wrote letters, helped **Leland** fix his car

April 7-Attended Church, gave my talk, attended a "Conjoint" meeting, Leland went to Coalman(sp)

April 8-a lot of drifting snow, **Dad (WC)** towed a couple of them, and they stayed here overnight

April 9-worked on family records, listened to a play "Death Valley Days", **Clyde** came home from Stirling

April 11-**Mother (Lulu)** got family history from her aunt in Utah and I put it my Book of Remembrance

April 12-attended Scout meeting, no leaders, poor meeting

April 13-**Leland** went to the show “David Copperfield” (movie-where?)

April 14-attended Church today (3 meetings), walked to “Home Teaching” visits

April 15-**Dad (WC)** is “in continuing motion” over the sugar factory business

April 16-wrote a history exam today, read articles from the Era (magazine)

April 17-wrote a couple of exams, did ok,

April 18-Our school teacher –Mr. Reid said goodbye (finished teaching), had Scouts, building fires

April 19-**Pap (WC)** canceled my trip to Lethbridge and Calgary, burned weeds instead

April 21-relatives visited from Raymond (Mary and Joe Thompson, Agnes and Cliff Price)-good visit
